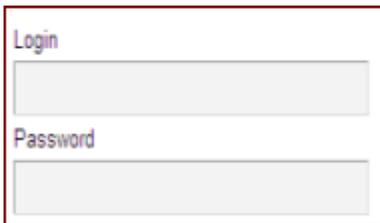

What is base-library.nhs.uk?

Base-library.nhs.uk provides access to the services and collections of 20 NHS libraries across Birmingham, the Black Country and Solihull, collectively known as BASE.

Logging in to Your Account

Click on '**My Account**' or '**Log in to your account**'

My Account

my summary

Displays the items you have on loan, their due dates, number of renewals and the option to renew them.

my fines

Breaks down any charges on your account, what's owed and been paid and the date.

my personal details

Enables you to update any of your registration details if they change including; names, contact numbers, addresses.

change my password

Here you can change your password from the default '1111' or if you suspect your current password may have been compromised.

my search history

You can look back at all the searches you have performed in the past and when you performed them.

my reading history

Keeps a complete list of all the items you have ever borrowed from BASE libraries.

my lists

Lets you view all the items you have saved when searching the catalogue.

Enter your search terms in the box and click **Go** to display search results from all 20 BASE libraries.

Use the dropdown menu to search by Author, Title, ISBN.

BASE Advanced Searching

Click on

Search For:

Combine 3 search terms to optimise your search results, for example performing an author and title search. Combine searches using OR, AND or NOT.

Publication Date Range:

In combination with your search terms you can limit the results by the year of publication.

Item Type:

This allows you to limit your search results to display just Books, DVDs or only Journals for example.

Location and Availability :

Limit the search to just your 'home' library, any other BASE library or just to items currently on the shelf.

Sorting:

Allows you to sort your results by Date, Relevance etc.

Once you have entered and selected all your search information click on **Search**.

6 Actions:  Place Reserve/Hold  Save to Lists  Add to My Items

- 1 The title of the items retrieved, to get more details click on the title.
- 2 The Authors of the item.
- 3 This will tell you if the item is a book, journal, DVD etc.
- 4 Tells you the publishers name and the date published.
- 5 Tells you which BASE library the item is available from and where it is located on the library shelves.
- 6 This is where you decide what action you want to perform next.

Placing a Reservation / Hold

- 1 Click on Reserve/Place Hold under the desired item.
- 2 If you do not need the hold after a certain date enter the date here.
- 3 Use the dropdown menu to select the collection library.
- 4 Click on **Place Hold**.
